### **2020 2021 Quality Rated Orientation – Virtual**

#### **Competency: ECE1.3**

This workshop provides an introduction and overview of the Environment Rating Scales (ERS) that are used by DECAL as a tool to assess programs participating in Georgia's Quality Rated (QR) system. This interactive training will encourage and energize early learning professionals by helping them realize the powerful impact they make every day and the simple practices that raise quality and increase impact.

### **Helping Children Bounce Back: Childhood Trauma and Resilience**

**2 Credit Hours**

#### **Competency: ECE1.1, ECE1.2, ECE1.4, ECE4.1**

Studies show that well over half of the children in the United States have experienced trauma by the time they turn 18 years old. The signs of trauma are often mislabeled and treated as behavior to be managed. This training will help meet the need of early educators to be able to more readily recognize the signs of trauma in children in their classes, as well as how to teach children skills to help them become more resilient and healthy.

### **On TRACK with Art 1**

**1 Credit Hour**

#### **Competency: ECE 5.6**

This introduction to visual arts in the ECE setting will equip and motivate teachers to engage children through practical and educational creative expression and discovery experiences.

### **On TRACK with Blocks 1**

**1 Credit Hour**

#### **Competency: ECE 5.4**

This introduction to block play in the ECE setting will equip and motivate teachers to engage children through practical and educational experiences.

**On TRACK with Math 1****1 Credit Hour****Competency: ECE 5.6**

This introduction to math in the ECE setting will equip and motivate teachers to engage children through practical and educational experiences.

**On TRACK with Science 1****1 Credit Hour****Competency: ECE 5.6**

This introduction to science in the ECE setting will equip and motivate teachers to engage children through practical and educational discovery experiences.

**Online Edition: On Track with Center Play****1 Credit Hour****Competency: ECE1.3, ECE4.1, ECE4.3**

This introduction to center play in the ECE setting will equip and motivate teachers to engage children through practical and educational discovery experiences. Participants will consider how to prepare centers for child engagement, and the teacher's role throughout center play.

**Online Edition - Ready to Learn! Setting the Stage for Active Engagement****1 Credit Hour****Competency: ECE1.1, ECE4.1, ECE4.3**

This training explores the core components of supporting a child in becoming actively engaged. Active Engagement is often confused with other things, like being obedient, compliant, or cooperative. But it's much more than that. When a child is actively engaged, that child is tuned-in to what is happening and open to creativity, exploring, learning, and to all sorts of possibilities.

**Online Version - Lesson Planning with Purpose: Linking GELDS & Learning****1 Credit Hour****Competency: ECE4.2, ECE5.1**

Participants will sharpen their skills in lesson planning and documentation to support the needs of their children and to align with the Georgia Early Learning and Development Standards (GELDS).

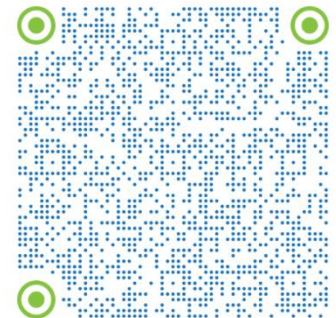
**Cash** may be dropped off at our office during our normal business hours: Monday - Friday 8:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
