POWER Up! Group Play Essentials for the Preschool Classroom

1 Credit Hour

Competency: ECE 4.3, 5.3

Focusing on large group play with 3 – 5 year old children, this training will share some tools, tips, and resources to help teachers do more with less effort, while at the same time improving the quality of their efforts and increasing positive outcomes for the children.

Participants will sharpen their skills in lesson planning and documentation to support the needs of their children and to align with the Georgia Early Learning and Development Standards (GELDS).

Helping Children Bounce Back: Childhood Trauma and Resilience Competency: ECE 1.1, 1.2, 1.4, 4.1

2 Credit Hours

Participants will learn that trauma is a common experience in most children's lives and how to use developmentally appropriate teaching strategies to help children learn how to cope with stress and develop resiliency skills.

Free play is an essential part of each day for infants and toddlers. This training offers participants the opportunity to reflect on their current practice and explore ways to support the play and development of children in their care by continuous quality improvement.

On TRACK with Blocks I

Competency: ECE 5.4

1 Credit Hour

This introduction to block play in the ECE setting will equip and motivate teachers to engage children through practical and educational experiences.

Behavior Bootcamp-Basic Training for a Preschool Class Competency: ECE 1.2, 1.4

2 Credit Hours

This training is designed for preschool teachers who are just starting out, have little experience in preschool classrooms, or just wanting a refresher in the basics of working with preschool classes.
