Early Care and Education BULLETIN!

Dear Child Care Professionals of Georgia:

Among the very most important activities that happen in early education classrooms every day are the countless interactions you have with young children. Whether you are reading stories to preschoolers, teaching rhymes to your Pre-K class, or taking conversational turns with a cooing infant, you are building the foundational skills for literacy as well as cognitive and social-emotional development.

I want to take this opportunity to celebrate the progress we have made in Georgia in preparing young children to become readers, and I want to thank you for your hard work. Last year we concluded a <u>six-year study</u> that followed a group of children from



Pre-K through fourth grade. It showed that a key strength of Georgia's Pre-K program is building foundational skills for reading. We know, of course, that this work begins earlier, in infant-toddler and preschool classes.

This achievement is the result of collaboration among teachers, early learning programs, the CCR&Rs and DECAL. Soon after I came to DECAL almost 20 years ago, another study of early learning programs in Georgia revealed that we were not doing enough to prepare young children for school. I had just come from a career in teaching, and I was disheartened that all our hard work was not enough.

At that time at DECAL we began to look closely at how we supported classroom teachers. We worked with our specialists to help teachers reflect on their interactions with children and focus on foundational skills like sound awareness and phonological awareness. Today we all share in the success reflected in the recent study of Pre-K.

There is still work to do in Georgia; and we at DECAL are continually looking for new ways to support early educators. DECAL has a wide variety of supports already in place, and I encourage you to take advantage of the coaching, training, salary supplements, and scholarships that we offer.

Thank you, again, for your daily labors of love.





Feed Kids this Summer by Operating a Happy Helpings Meal Site

It's not too late to participate in Happy Helpings, Georgia's Summer Food Service Program this summer. Working with an approved sponsor, your organization can operate a meal site and kids can benefit from up to two free nutritious meals per day.

DECAL will provide your organization with a list of approved sponsors that serve meals in your area. Once you select the sponsor, they will provide the meals and any required training, The sponsor will also receive the reimbursement for the meals.

Meal sites can be located in a variety of places such at apartment complexes, community centers, parks, churches, summer camps, community pools, but they must be located in a school zone where at least 50% of the children enrolled qualify for free or reduced priced meals.
