
#### Free Online Training Registration

- 1. Log in to your GaPDS account at <a href="https://gapds.decal.ga.gov/Login.aspx">https://gapds.decal.ga.gov/Login.aspx</a>
- 2. Choose "Trainings/Find Scheduled Training Sessions"
  - a. Search for the training title as listed in the Training Calendar.
- 3. Register for selected training session.
- 4. You will receive confirmation and reminder emails from GaPDS.
- 5. You will receive an email from <a href="mailto:leaptraining@augusta.edu">leaptraining@augusta.edu</a> one day prior to the training with a link to the training.
- 6. The day of the training, click the link to join us!

One participant per device provides the best experience for the learner and the easiest way to confirm attendance. In cases where multiple learners must use one device, we may ask for additional attendance confirmation via chat and/or email. This could include but is not limited to a live webcam view, time stamped photos of the group in the training, and/or signed statement confirming the learner's attendance from a program leader that was present for the training or a member of the group serving as the program leadership representative.

Per DECAL advisement, participants in trainings should <u>not</u> be actively caring for children during the training. If the training team suspects you are caring for children during the training, they will request that you leave the training and reschedule. If you do not leave, the training team reserves the right to remove you from the virtual training session and you will not be awarded credit for the training.
